The City of Maricopa, California is soliciting lump sum bids for all labor and materials to remove and dispose of 695 linear feet of existing perimeter fencing, one 18" double swing gate and hardware associated therewith and installation of 695 linear feet of security chain link fencing and associated hardware including an 18 foot double gate at the city's corporation yard located at 506 Poso Street (California State Highway166) in the city of Maricopa, California.

Required fencing shall be:

96" Chain Link Fence (Base)

Posts: 2 7/8" O.D. Terminal/End/Corner; 2 3/8" O.D. Line
Fabric: 9GA x 2" Mesh
Top rail: 1 5/8" O.D.
Post Caps: Dome Style
Ties: 9GA Steel Ties
Footings: Terminal posts 36" deep x 10"; Line Posts 36" x 10"
Concrete: 3000 PSI
Gate: 18' opg double swing gate w/ 6 5/8" O.D. posts

(OPTION) Add 18"/ 457mm Helical Razor Wire (Stainless Steel on Galvanized Core Wire) to 695 linear feet of perimeter fencing and to 18 foot double swing gates.

All work must be performed at prevailing wage rates in accordance with Public Contracts Code requirements.

Contractor agrees that the Work shall be performed by qualified, experienced and well-supervised personnel. All services performed in connection with this Construction Contract shall be performed in a manner consistent with the standard of care under California law applicable to those who specialize in providing such services for projects of the type, scope and complexity of the Project.

Contractor, at its sole expense, shall obtain and maintain during the term of this Construction Contract, all appropriate permits, licenses, and certificates that may be required in connection with the performance of services hereunder, including, but not limited to, a City of Maricopa business license.

For the duration of construction period, Contractor must maintain the following insurance:.

1. Commercial general liability in an amount not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) per occurrence. If food is sold, products liability coverage in an amount not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) An additional insured endorsement is required and must include coverage for the City, its mayor, council, officers, employees, volunteers, and agents under your commercial general liability policy.
2. Workers' compensation as required by the California Labor Code, if the permit holder uses its own employees in conducting the planned event or activity. Waiver of subrogation endorsement in required in favor of the City.
3. Automobile Liability in an amount not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) combined single limit covering owned, non-owned and hired vehicles.
